

**First Aliyah**

<sup>9</sup> This is the line of Noah.—Noah was a righteous man; he was blameless in his age; Noah walked with God.—<sup>10</sup> Noah begot three sons: Shem, Ham, and Japheth.

<sup>11</sup> The earth became corrupt before God; the earth was filled with lawlessness. <sup>12</sup> When God saw how corrupt the earth was, for all flesh had corrupted its ways on earth, <sup>13</sup> God said to Noah, “I have decided to put an end to all flesh, for the earth is filled with lawlessness because of them: I am about to destroy them with the earth. <sup>14</sup> Make yourself an ark of gopher wood; make it an ark with compartments, and cover it inside and out with pitch.

**Second Aliyah**

<sup>15</sup> This is how you shall make it: the length of the ark shall be three hundred cubits, its width fifty cubits, and its height thirty cubits. <sup>16</sup> Make an opening for daylight in the ark, and terminate it within a cubit of the top. Put the entrance to the ark in its side; make it with bottom, second, and third decks.

<sup>17</sup> “For My part, I am about to bring the Flood—waters upon the earth—to destroy all flesh under the sky in which there is breath of life; everything on earth shall perish. <sup>18</sup> But I will establish My covenant with you, and you shall enter the ark, with your sons, your wife, and your sons’ wives.

### **Third Aliyah**

<sup>19</sup> And of all that lives, of all flesh, you shall take two of each into the ark to keep alive with you; they shall be male and female. <sup>20</sup> From birds of every kind, cattle of every kind, every kind of creeping thing on earth, two of each shall come to you to stay alive. <sup>21</sup> For your part, take of everything that is eaten and store it away, to serve as food for you and for them.” <sup>22</sup> Noah did so; just as God commanded him, so he did.

### **Fourth Aliyah**

<sup>1</sup> Then the Lord said to Noah, “Go into the ark, with all your household, for you alone have I found righteous before Me in this generation. <sup>2</sup> Of every clean animal you shall take seven pairs, males and their mates, and of every animal that is not clean, two, a male and its mate; <sup>3</sup> of the birds of the sky also, seven pairs, male and female, to keep seed alive upon all the earth. <sup>4</sup> For in seven days’ time I will make it rain upon the earth, forty days and forty nights, and I will blot out from the earth all existence that I created.” <sup>5</sup> And Noah did just as the Lord commanded him.
